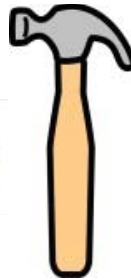
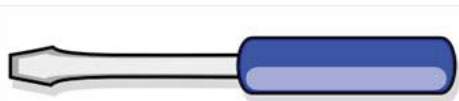
At this time, GITCo has approximately two formerly leased vehicles available for lease. Even though the cost of leasing a vehicle is \$1.00, a security deposit is required. This deposit will be used in the event the vehicle requires repairs so it is in good operating condition for the next Lessee. Vehicles are only leased to agencies or independent contractors. One or more St. Louis City residents must receive transportation in the leased vehicle. In addition, a specific alcohol and drug policy must be adopted should a vehicle be leased.

Policy Alteration

In the event an agency leases a vehicle that was leased previously, GITCo will pay for any repair work that may be required during the first 30 calendar days from the date of the Lease Supplement. After 30 calendar days, any and all repairs are the responsibility of the Lessee.
